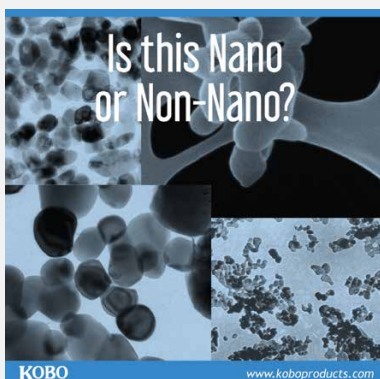


2021 Global Beauty Trends
